Junior Great Ireland Run 2011 Event Specific Terms & Conditions

1. ENTRY POLICY

1.1 By submitting your application on behalf of your child / dependant and paying the Fee you are agreeing to enter the Event and also agree to abide by the General Conditions of Entry, these Event Specific Conditions and any instructions given to your child / dependant by the organisers and officials of the Event.

1.2 To participate in the Event, your child / dependant must be at least 8-15 years of age on Sunday 10th April 2011.

1.3 Your child / dependants entry is individual to them and they may not transfer their entry to a different participant or to a different Great Run event.

2. FEES

2.1 The Fees for entry into the Event are €9/£9.19 per entry. Applications will be accepted up to the entry limit of 1000. Entries will be rejected after the closing date of 22 March 2011, or earlier should the entry limit be reached before this date.

2.2 For UK Entries all Fees are inclusive of VAT.

2.3 Your child / dependant entry is accepted the Fee is non refundable other than as otherwise stated in the Agreement.

3. VISUALLY IMPAIRED / MEDICALLY ASSISTED RUNNERS

Entries from blind or visually impaired runners are welcome, however all such participants must be accompanied by another paying entrant. It is strongly advised that the blind runner and his /her guide should be appropriately identified, and must be linked together. A limited number of assisted start places ahead of the main race may be available, and will be at the discretion of the Race Director.

4. DEFERMENT

4.1 If your child / dependant subsequently decides not to participate in the Event prior to the Event Date we may, at our discretion, permit your child / dependant to defer their entry in the Event until the next similar event (a "Deferment").

4.2 All requests for a Deferment are final. Once your child / dependants Deferment is accepted they cannot be re-instated to the Event.

4.3 All requests for a Deferment must be made prior to the Event. No requests for a Deferment will be considered retrospectively.

4.4 If your child / dependants entry was procured via one of the guaranteed Charity partners, the deferred place will be offered back to the charity for the next year's event.

4.5 To request a Deferment you should contact us by post prior to the Event Date. We will only consider requests for a Deferment if they are postmarked before the Event Date. In your request for a Deferment you must clearly state your child / dependants name, address, date of birth and the confirmation must be signed by you. You must also return their timing chip if they are entered into the Junior Event. Their request for a Deferment should be returned in the pre-paid timing chip envelope provided within your entry pack.

4.6 If we accept their request for a Deferment we will contact you by email prior to opening the application process for the next Event. You will have a period of 28 days from being contacted by us to confirm your place and pay any additional fees (if necessary). If you do not confirm their place within this time period your right to a deferment is forfeited along with any fees you may have paid and we shall have no further liability towards you.

5. LOST OR MISSING EVENT NUMBERS

5.1 If your child / dependant has not received their information pack one week before the Event Date you should e-mail us at the following address info@greatrun.org.

5.2 All enquiries relating to the non-arrival of run packs or lost run packs that we are unable to resolve prior to the Event Date will be handled at the Event. We will not be able to consider an enquiry unless you are able to provide appropriate photographic ID.

General Conditions of Entry to Junior & Mini Great Run Events ©

In these Conditions the following definitions shall apply:

"Agreement" the agreement between you and us comprised of the Event Conditions and these Conditions of Entry;

"Event" the event organised by Nova International Limited;

"Event Conditions" the terms and conditions, in addition to these Conditions of Entry, provided to you by Nova International Limited in respect of the Event;

"Event Date" the date of the Event, as specified in the Event Conditions;

"Fee" the fee payable by you to Nova International Limited in consideration of your participation in the Event, as specified in the Event Conditions;

"we", "Great Run" means Nova International Limited trading as Great Run; and

"you" Means the parent or guardian aged over 16 for whom you are responsible

"your child / dependant" means the Event participant, aged under 16

1. ENTRY

1.1 By submitting your application and paying the Fee you are agreeing to enter your child/dependant into the Event and also agree to abide by these Conditions of Entry, the Event Conditions and any instructions given to you by the organisers and officials of the Event.

1.2 Included within the Junior information pack will be an electronic chip to record your time, this should be used in accordance with the instructions in the information pack. You agree to return the electronic chip at designated points located near to the finish line of the Event or within 30 days by post to Great Run, P.O Box 1RY, Newcastle Upon Tyne, NE99 1RY. If you fail to return the electronic chip, we will be entitled to charge you £10 for the replacement cost of the chip.

1.3 Participants in the Event are subject to the UKA competition rules. If there is any conflict between the UKA competition rules and the Agreement, the Agreement shall apply to the extent of the conflict.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1 If your address details change after you have submitted your application, you can login to your child / dependants profile on www.greatrun.org and change their postal address. Approximately 3 weeks before the Event your information pack will be sent to the address held at that point. If you have any queries regarding this please email details of your old and new addresses and your child / dependants date of birth to info@greatrun.org or write to Nova International Limited, P.O Box 1RY, Newcastle Upon Tyne, NE99 1RY.

2.2 We take no responsibility for items lost or misplaced in the post or, if you fail to comply with condition 2.1, for items despatched to the wrong address.

3. EVENT SAFETY

3.1 At all times during the Event your child / dependant must adhere to all instructions given by the Event officials.

3.2 It is your responsibility to ensure that your child/dependant has the correct equipment, footwear and clothing for the Event, taking the weather conditions into account.

3.3 Your child / dependant is not permitted to be accompanied by your pets or other animals when participating in the Event.

3.4 Participation in the Event is personal to your child / dependant; you are strictly prohibited from swapping, selling or transferring the place in the Event or allowing any other person to wear the Event number. If you are found to be in breach of this Condition 3.4 we reserve the right to exclude your child / dependant from participation in future Events

3.5 Your child / dependant is not permitted to use the following items in the Event:-

3.5.1 roller skates;

3.5.2 wheel barrows;

3.5.3 cycles; or

3.5.4 any other item that could potentially inhibit the flow or safety of other participants or which we, in our reasonable opinion, deem may cause danger or risk of danger to your child / dependants or other participants.

3.6 Your child / dependant will only be permitted to wear fancy dress costumes for certain Events as expressly stated in the Event Conditions, and in any event we reserve the right to prevent your child / dependant from participating in the Event if we determine in our sole discretion that the fancy dress outfit may cause danger or risk of danger to other participants.

3.7 You warrant to Nova International Limited that your child / dependant will be on the Event Date, sufficiently fit and healthy to participate in the Event unaided and in accordance with the Agreement. If you are in any doubt we recommend that you take your child / dependant to seek medical advice.

4. EVENT EJECTION

4.1 We reserve the right to refuse entry to the Event or to ask your child / dependant to cease participation if:-

4.1.1 Your child / dependant fails to follow instructions given by Event officials;

4.1.2 Your child / dependant attempts to participate in the Event in a manner that we, acting reasonably, believe:-

(a) may cause injury to your child / dependant;

(b) may cause injury to another participant;

(c) may damage or harm the environment;

(d) is likely to cause offence; or

(e) otherwise causes a risk or potential risk to health and safety including any failure, in whole or in part, to comply with the restrictions in Condition 3 (Event Safety);

4.1.3 in our opinion your child / dependant is unfit to participate in the Event due to:-

(a) the consumption of alcohol;

(b) the use of drugs;

(c) an injury or illness; or

4.1.4 your child / dependant fails to arrive at the start location at the specified time; or

4.1.5 your child / dependant is unable to make sufficient progress in the Event to allow him / her to complete the event in line with timelines set by Event officials, as identified by the last support vehicle.

4.2 If, in accordance with Condition 4.1, your child / dependant is refused entry to the Event or we ask your child / dependant to cease participation in the Event, they must remove their runner's identification number and electronic chip (if applicable) and return them to an Event official. If your child / dependants ignores our instructions to cease participation in the Event and continue or chose to follow the Event course your child / dependant will do so at their own risk.

5. CANCELLATION BY YOU

5.1 You should inform Nova International Limited immediately, in writing to info@greatrun.org if your child / dependant incurs an injury or develops a medical condition which prevents them from participating in the Event and means that they need to withdraw. If you provide supporting medical evidence of such injury or medical condition we may, at our discretion refund the Fee.

5.2 We reserve the right to retain £5.00 from any refund given in accordance with condition 4.1.2 as a contribution to administration costs

6. CANCELLATION BY NOVA INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

6.1 We may cancel the Event if circumstances beyond our reasonable control arise, including, without limitation, war, civil or political unrest, terrorism or inclement weather conditions.

6.2 We may cancel the Event if one month before the Event Date we have not, in our sole discretion, received sufficient number of applications to ensure that there are enough participants to make the Event economically viable.

6.3 In such circumstances:-

6.3.1 we will, if practicable, provide written notice of cancellation to the address we hold for your child / dependant. In the event that written notice is not practicable due to the timescales involved we will use reasonable endeavours to provide other suitable methods of notice including, e-mail, mobile phone, text message, television and radio broadcasts; and

6.3.2 you will receive a refund of the Fee.

6.4 In the event of cancellation of the Event we will have no responsibility for any costs incurred as a result of cancellation including any travel or accommodation costs, including your and your child / dependants travel to the Event location.

6.5 If in the following circumstances:-

6.5.1 we cancel the Event if circumstances beyond our reasonable control arise, or

6.5.2 we cancel the Event in accordance with Condition 6.2,

we reserve the right to retain £5.00 from the refund of the Fee as a contribution to administration costs.

7. DATA PROTECTION

7.1 For the purposes of this Condition 7, personal information includes medical data collected for health and safety purposes ("Personal Information").

7.2 You agree that the Personal Information relating to your child / dependant can be stored, used by Nova International Limited and our Event partners in connection with the organisation, staging and administration of the Event.

7.3 Medical information will only be used to allow medical assistance to be given on the Event Date.

7.4 You agree that the Personal Information relating to your child / dependant may be anonymised and the anonymised data may be used by Nova International Limited and our Event partners in connection with the compilation of statistical information and to improve health and safety procedures at future events.

7.5 You agree that the name and contact details of your child / dependant can be used by Nova International Limited and our Event partners for the purposes of:-

7.5.1 the promotion and marketing of the Event;

7.5.2 adding you to a mailing list to keep you informed about any future events and services which we believe you might be interested in, such as leisure activities relating to either similar types of events or activities;

7.5.3 promotional and marketing material in respect of similar events, other community based activities organised by our Event Partners,

(together the "Marketing Information"). If you object to such, please see Condition 7.7.

7.6 We shall take all necessary steps to ensure that Personal Information or Marketing Information belonging or relating to your child / dependant which comes into the possession or control of Nova International Limited or our Event partners shall not be:-

7.6.1 used or reproduced in whole or in part in any form except for the purposes outlined in these Conditions;

7.6.2 disclosed to any person not authorised by you to receive it; or

7.6.3 altered, deleted, added to or otherwise interfered with (except where expressly permitted by these Conditions).

7.7 If you would not like Nova International Limited or our Event partners to use the Marketing Information or Personal Information other than for purposes related solely to your child / dependant participation in the Event, please e-mail Nova International Limited at info@greatrun.org You may also withdraw your consent by ticking the appropriate box on your application form.

7.8 By agreeing to the terms and conditions your child / dependant will receive a welfare email which will include training information and a final update on the Event itself.

8. CHANGES TO THE EVENT

8.1 We reserve the right to reduce the course distance, change the course, or make any other amendment to the Event that we deem necessary to stage the Event. Any change to the Event will be communicated to your child / dependant at the Event or sooner if practicable.

8.2 Should the course distance be reduced in accordance with Condition 8.1 for the avoidance of doubt you agree that the Event is still deemed to be staged and that we will not be liable to you for any refund in respect of the entry for your child / dependant.

9. USE OF IMAGE

9.1 The Event may be televised and photographs may be taken which capture the participation of your child / dependant in the Event. You agree to the publication of photographs and broadcasts of your child / dependant which accurately depict their participation in the Event in the context of a report which relates solely to the Event as such.

9.2 The photograph, image, name or voice of your child / dependant will not be used in any other specific broadcast, telecast, advertising, promotion or other medium without your consent.

9.3 Whilst we will make reasonable endeavours to capture a photograph of every event participant which will then be offered to each participant for purchase we do not offer a guarantee that images will be captured.

10. FINISHERS PACK

Your child / dependant will only receive a finisher's pack if they complete the Event. No finisher's packs will be provided to spectators or participants who do not complete the Event. Great Run reserves the right to change the style, size and type of mementos offered in the finishers pack.

11. TAKING PART FOR A CHARITY

11.1 Entry to the Event will be acknowledged via a confirmation email. If your child / dependant is taking part to raise money for a charity you and your child / dependant should not enter into any sponsorship raising until you receive this email.

12. MEDICAL CONDITIONS

12.1 It is recommended that your child / dependant trains for the Event and prepares for the challenge. If your child / dependant has not exercised before or for some time, you may wish to consult your doctor before commencing your training for the Event.

12.2 You must complete the contact / medical details of your child / dependant on the back of the race number prior to participating in the Event.

13. LIABILITY

13.1 In no event shall we be liable to you, your child or dependant whether for breach of contract, any tortious act or omission (including negligence) or otherwise, under or in connection with the Agreement for any:

13.1.1 loss or damage;

13.1.2 loss of profit;

13.1.3 loss of reputation;

13.1.4 loss of business, revenue or goodwill;

13.1.5 loss of anticipated savings;

13.1.6 pledges made on your behalf or by you or your child / dependant to charity; or

13.1.7 consequential or indirect loss, regardless of whether the loss or damage:

(a) would arise in the ordinary course of events;

(b) is reasonably foreseeable; or

(c) is in the contemplation of the parties, or otherwise.

13.2 Nothing in this Agreement shall affect our liability for death or personal injury, fraud, or any other liability to the extent it cannot be excluded or limited by law.

14. DEFERMENT POLICY

14.1 Once we have confirmed the participation of your child / dependant in the Event we will not provide any refund if you choose to cancel the Agreement other than in accordance with Condition 5.

14.2 If you have a confirmed place at the Event for your child / dependant and subsequently decide not to participate we may provide you with an opportunity to defer the entry of your child / dependant to another similar Event. Please see the Event Conditions for further information about deferring your participation in the Event.

15. GENERAL

15.1 If there is a conflict or inconsistency between any provision contained in the body of these Conditions of Entry and any provision contained in the Event Conditions, except where provided to the contrary in the latter, the Event Conditions prevail to the extent of the conflict or inconsistency.

15.2 The Agreement shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

15.3 If any provision of the Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, in whole or in part, the validity of the remainder shall not be affected.

15.4 The Agreement does not create, confer or purport to confer any benefit or right enforceable by any person not party to it.

15.5 Nothing in the Agreement shall have the effect of holding the Partners out as being a partnership, joint venture, principal or agent of each other or of Nova International Limited.
